Project or Activity Title

Installation of CCTV with audio recording at the external front entrance and rear garden.

Purpose of the Processing

To promote the safety and security of children, staff, parents, and visitors, and to:

- Deter unauthorised access and antisocial behaviour.
- Monitor safeguarding concerns during drop-off/pick-up times and outdoor play.
- Support investigations into incidents occurring in outdoor areas.

Description of the Processing

Element	Details
Type of Data	Video and audio recordings (audio is
	external only). No facial recognition or
	biometric data.
Recording Areas	External front entrance and rear garden
	only. No internal rooms have audio
	recording.
Audio Capture	Conversations near entrances and in the
	outdoor play space may be recorded. No
	two-way audio function.
Storage & Retention	Data stored securely on an encrypted
	system. Retained for up to 30 days, unless
	required for an investigation.
Access	Only senior management and DSLs have
	access. Access is logged and monitored.

Legal Basis for Processing

Processing is based on Legitimate Interests under Article 6(1)(f) of UK GDPR:

"Processing is necessary for the purposes of the legitimate interests pursued by the controller... except where such interests are overridden by the interests or fundamental rights and freedoms of the data subject."

Safeguarding and security of children and staff justify the limited use of audio outdoors.

Proportionality	Audio is restricted to external areas
	where there is no reasonable expectation
	of private conversation.
Minimisation	No audio inside the nursery. No recording
	in toilets, changing rooms, or sleep areas.
Transparency	Clear signage in place. Privacy notice
	updated. Staff and parents informed.
Access Controls	Only designated staff can view
	recordings. Audit logs maintained.

Risks Identified and Mitigations

Risk	Mitigation
Privacy concerns over audio recording	Audio is limited to external areas only; no
	audio indoors. Clear signage and privacy
	notices issued.
Unauthorised access to footage	Secure system with restricted access,
	password protection, and access logs.
Misuse of audio recordings	Staff trained on data handling. Policy
	prohibits use for non-safeguarding or
	disciplinary monitoring.
Data breach	Encrypted storage and regular security
	updates. Regular review of system access
	and retention.
